Acknowledgements/Accomplishments Jillian & Alicia attended CADCA Mid-Year with 5 TAB members; Registration is now open for JCDEC on October 18th; Registration for Youth Drug Education Conference is open- please promote to Jefferson County High School Students!; Walgreens is hopeful that Missouri wording about having drop boxes in places that sell prescriptions will be altered; Attended the Back To School Resource Fair on July 26th
- 3. TRAINING/GROUP DISCUSSION (20 minutes):

Topic: "CASA of Jefferson County" (Amy Baum) – Court Appointed Special Advocates. They have 65 volunteers serving over 100 kids. They are working to serve every child in foster care in our county. We have a severe shortage of foster care homes- only 61-62 in Jefferson County so they are spread around the St. Louis area. There is so much inconsistency, tend to have multiple case workers, change of living, etc. The case worker is the person who is making sure they are cared for and if that changes, the new worker won't see the change in the child who is in foster care. What a volunteer does- doesn't need any special qualifications- needs to have a passion for helping children in need and needs to have their own stability. They go through a 5 week flex training course and are sworn in to be able to help the child and are matched with who CASA feels would be a good child/adult match. CASA is a 501c3 and funded by grants and fundraising. Biggest funder is Victims of Crime Act federal grant and large support from Jefferson Foundation.

Drug Free Communities Survey went out last week to determine JCDPC monthly meetings beginning on October 1st (Results from 31 respondents: 46%= 1st Wednesday of the month, 71%= 9:00-10:30am, 87%= Arnold location). Arnold JCHD is not available on the first Wednesday of every month, so JCDPC is looking at other options in Arnold (Jefferson College's campus is confirmed to be available. Suggested to look at Arnold Rec Ctr & Care Connections facilities as options); Still need help putting drop box location yard signs around Jefferson County; Working on cleaning out JCDPC's office in preparation for move to JCHD (plan to bring items to September meeting to see if anyone could use items); Working on purchasing Talk About It campaign materials and getting pricing (cost for unit and disposal) for a sharps disposal kiosk for community members to utilize
