ASSURE SAFETY

KNOW THE PLANS

- Know who is driving to and from
- Tell your parents the plans and ensure they are ok with them. Be sure to include where and when of before and after plans
- Talk to your parent about curfew
- Stay safe and sober. And HAVE FUN!

AFTER PARTY

- NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS
- Host your own alcohol and drug-free party
- If you can't find a safe party attend an alternative event like bowling, late dinner, midnight movie etc
- If friends leave party, they can't return

GENERAL SAFETY

- Get your own beverages and/or watch them being made
- Come up with a plan with your parent/guardians in case your environment becomes unsafe and they can "rescue" you.
- Leave a party where alcohol or drugs are present

THINGS TO KNOW

MIP STATUE

Missouri law states that if police find a minor visibly intoxicated or that minor has a detectable blood alcohol concentration above .02 and is under the age of 21, he or she can be charge with a minor in possession (MIP) by consumption.
