- 3. TRAINING/GROUP DISCUSSION (20 minutes):

Topic: "Care Connections" (Kristin Charlesworth) - Kristin is Director of Care Connections. In partnership with St. John's Lutheran in Arnold. Funded by the Lutheran Foundation so can provide services to those outside of Jefferson County. Second Thursday is Care Coordination and they offer walk in services to find strengths and needs of the client. It is an intensive case management program. Look at 5 areas of health to make goals- financial, mental health, spiritual, physical health and relationships. To help give a support system and have people take responsibility for their actions. If a community partner contacts them and it isn't the 2nd Thursday of the month, they get that person on the schedule. There is no timeline on how long they keep the client. Care Connections also has grief support groups, Parenting a Second Time Around- geared towards grandparents who are raising kids after their own are grown (someone else's kids or grandkids). Also offers cancer support groups. For Jefferson County residents there is free counseling through Lutheran family services. Strengthening Families is a parenting program to reduce child abuse and neglect (could be moms that are struggling or families struggling and maybe losing kids- Drug and alcohol discussion is included). Divorce counseling offered as well. There are different modules for parents of different age groups and they have parents and children separate except for certain activities to role play etc... SJL.org/events shows all events and classes. Residents are encouraged to start classes from week 1
