Acknowledgements/Accomplishments Stephen Sutler celebrated 1 year of sobriety on Monday; Stephen will also be working with the Aces group at Fox; JCHD's Community Health Fair was well attended; NCADA's Talk About It Community Day; First successful "Live Healthy, Jefferson County" radio show w/ JCHD (topics: disaster preparedness, protection from ticks/mosquitoes, DEA takeback & medicine safety/disposal); Chief Medical Officer at Mercy has had positive feedback from providers after he sent out the surgeon general's advisory regarding naloxone; Have updated Drop box flyer- might update further if we receive CARA grant; Fox had a meeting about the MSS and they agreed to take part the next round
- 3. TRAINING/GROUP DISCUSSION (20 minutes):

Topic: "Wellness Van" (Jefferson County Health Dept) – 1/3 of the mobile health units come from one place so the data from this presentation comes from there. Help to address the medical and social determinants of health. They represent a cost effective care delivery model and improve health outcomes in underserved groups. Some people are intimidated by the large healthcare systems. The health department is trying to overcome transportation issues, insurance issues, etc. About 60 % of people seen in an emergency room can be handled in a primary care setting. There is a \$12 savings for every \$1 spent. CDC recommends 3 areas of prevention- traditional clinical preventative care, total population or community wide interventions, and innovative interventions that extend care outside the clinical setting. Services that will be offered: urgent care, preventative health screenings, initiation of chronic disease management, and sports and other physicals. Other units have shown evidence of patient increase in self care and confidence to do so and confidence in health. The risks include fragmentation of care, finances, constraints of space and clinical structure, and the challenges of logistical planning. DeSoto Library will house the unit the week of May 21. Something to note: parents have to be there for physicals.
