  - b. Teen Advisory Board (TAB)/JMCF Youth Leadership Development Grant- Had TAB Retreat yesterday. Teens learned ways they can approach their peers, more specifically their friends, on talking about drug use and their behaviors/decisions. Did some strategic planning for the upcoming year. The final write up is due Feb 1 and grant for June is due Feb 15<sup>th</sup>.

- New ideas/thoughts: Media Education; Video highlighting first responders similar to St Charles; Utilize advertisements in Leader during drug awareness weeks; Role play between parents and their kids (utilize theatrical programs in schools?); Parental mentorship program; 1 minute messages for parents and kids; Collaborate with Boy Scout and Girl Scout troops; Back to school fair – Highlight ways for parents to model behavior
